## <u>Why go?</u>

- An opportunity to challenge yourself and grow in the process!
- A chance to connect with God, your church and the community in the Upper Peninsula.
- An opportunity to cross the Mackinaw bridge, see Lake Superior, Whitefish Bay, Tahquamenon River and more!
- To partner with others and learn the impact that provides in your own life.
- A chance to use and learn skills we might not otherwise experience carpentry, hard and soft scape, painting, brick work, siding, sewing, etc.

## What to expect:

- A six+ hour journey.
- A lodging mission experience (gender specific dorm space or off site).
- Chores at the dorm and around meals.
- Hard work, getting dirty, getting clean, laughter, and sometimes tears.
- Caring, Commitment, Community
- Bugs, critters, sun, rain, and so much more...
- Fellowship, games, smiles, and FUN.
- Time spent reflecting on your faith journey, relationship with God and others!

## Who can participate:

The GCCP MQ trip is *recommended* for: **individuals** (youth\* & adults) **and family teams** (age 12 and up)! \*The difficulty of some projects and nature of this trip make it better suited for high school aged students or middle school students who have a previous mission experience with FUMC Northville. Please feel free to contact Tracy to discuss your individual/family situation! Please note that Safe Sanctuary requirements may limit some activities for any unaccompanied minors. Unaccompanied minors are required by GCCP to **procure a notarized permission form** (it will be given to you after registration to complete with a notary).

Per GCCP: ALL participants are asked to be fully vaccinated two weeks prior to departure or to provide a negative covid test within 72 hours of arrival at GCCP.

## Cost/Payments/Training:

**Cost is expected to be \$325.00\* per participant.** A **\$25.00 credit** will be given to anyone who completes their registration by **April 2<sup>nd</sup>**. The FINAL deadline to register is **May 7th**.

**INCLUDED:** Lodging at GCCP, Monday dinner through Friday breakfast, our project materials for our mission work, staff support for GCCP and your individual VIM required insurance policy.

#### Transportation:

<u>Provide your own</u>: Each family/team will provide their own transportation and cover fuel and any other tolls/expenses on the trip. If you should opt to procure your own lodging, the cost is in addition to the \$325 registration fee (lodging is group flat rate and this includes our food).

**\*Unaccompanied Minors** or others requesting to use group transportation will have an additional cost of **\$175.00** to *help* cover our vehicle and fuel expenses (Limited number of seats available-first come first serve).

**Extra activities:** This could include State Parks (pass fees), activity expenses, and outings for ice cream, etc.

#### <u>May 7:</u>

- First **Payment** Due: with all forms from GCCP: \$150.00/person (+\$175.00 *if opting for group transportation*)

- Training/info meeting, 9am-12:30 (Mandatory)

#### <u>June 4:</u>

- Balance **Payment** Due: \$175.00/person or less (you will be given a balance based on your discounts: applicable service hour credits, early registration, or leader incentive). -**Training/info meeting**, 9am-12:30 (*Tentative 2nd meeting*)

## WHAT TO PACK:

# Please! Be mindful that space is limited in the dorm/lodging area. Make sure your gear fits in two bags for

**everything**! Note, those providing their own transportation will be able to store some items in their vehicle.

-<u>Pillow and linens</u> (or sleeping bag) for extra-long bunk beds.

- -<u>Toiletries and towel</u> (Biodegradable products appreciated)
- -<u>SHOES</u>: Sturdy shoes (sneakers or work boots), Shower shoes/beach shoes
- -<u>CLOTHING</u>: Camp and project appropriate T-shirts(5), long shorts(2), long pants(2), long sleeve shirt, hoodie/jacket, socks, underwear. Please avoid designer/status labels and strive for appropriateness if you are questioning something that is a good indicator to leave it at home.
- -<u>SWIM</u>: Bathing suit & towel (suits should be **modest and sturdy** board shorts are a good option for any gender!)
- -<u>OTHER</u>: Sunscreen, bug spray, hat, sunglasses, safety glasses, work gloves, **Refillable Water Bottle**, Flashlight, **Bike Helmet** (bikes provided)
- -<u>Spending money</u> (should be labeled and locked in vehicle of your driver. Hopefully we can purchase locally made items.)

#### -Your best attitude and an intention to find God!

## What NOT to bring:

- Earbuds/headphones (If needed for sleeping, they can NOT be used during the day, and you must follow all related rules)
- Electric hair appliances of any sort.
- -Anything you would be upset if it got wet, broken or went missing! If you bring it, be willing to part with it
- -Anything not allowed by church rules (drugs, alcohol, tobacco, weapons, etc.) If you aren't sure about something, ASK!
- -Anything that would not be <u>sensitive</u> (think three Ss of mission work) to our partners, GCCP, or the community!
